Onderwerp: Canada - Refined Sugar - Re-investigation of AD and CV measures

Dear Member States' representatives,

On **6 October 2021**, the Canadian authorities initiated a re-investigation concerning the anti-dumping and countervailing measures on imports of **refined sugar** originating in or exported from the European Union, United States of America, and the United Kingdom.

- 1 **Product:** Refined sugar, refined from sugar cane or sugar beets, in granulated, liquid and powdered form
- 2 **Country taking action:** Canada
- 3 **EU Countries concerned:** Dumping: Denmark, Germany, the Netherlands Subsidisation: All EU Member States
- 4 **Other countries concerned:** USA, UK
- 5 **Type of case:** Re-investigation of anti-dumping and countervailing measures. Canada will recalculate normal values and export prices and amounts of subsidy.

- 7 **Tariff codes:** 1701 and 1702. See the Notice of initiation for more details on the product definition.

- 8 **Comments:**
 - **Anti-dumping duties:** For imports of subject goods originating in/or exported from Denmark, Germany and the Netherlands the anti-dumping duty is equal to 180% of the export price.
 - **Countervailing duties:** For imports of subject goods originating in/or exported from the European Union, the countervailing duty is equal to 24.39 Euros per 100kg.
